



<p>Violation(s):</p> <p>Officer Colletti was found to be at-fault/careless involving a serious violation and, pursuant to the department's 'Crashes Involving City Vehicles' policy (4.2.3.22) and three points are being assessed.</p>	
<p>Summary: (attach additional sheets as needed)</p> <p>On November 21, 2014, at 11:37 pm, Officer Colletti was operating marked Palm Beach Gardens Police vehicle # 11421, a 2011 Dodge Charger. Officer Colletti was southbound on Alternate A1A and was stopped in the left turn lane to go east on Lighthouse Drive. A second vehicle, a 2010 Ford Fusion 4 door, was traveling northbound on Alternate A1A. Officer Colletti indicated that he was going to stop a vehicle that was in front of him and turned left to travel east on Lighthouse Drive into the path of the 2010 Ford Fusion. Officer Colletti had not activated his emergency overhead lights. The driver of the Ford Fusion indicated that the traffic signal was green and the police vehicle made a left turn, pulling directly into her path resulting in the vehicles colliding. The front of the Ford Fusion struck the front right corner of the Palm Beach Gardens police vehicle. The on-scene crash investigation determined that Officer Colletti was at-fault for failure to yield the right-of-way.</p> <p>The driver of the Ford Fusion complained of knee and neck injuries and was transported to Palm Beach Gardens Medical Center for treatment. The damage to the police vehicle is approximately \$900. and the Ford Fusion sustained approximately \$3,000. worth of damage.</p>	
<p>Recommendation:</p> <p>Officer Colletti was found to be at-fault/careless involving a serious violation and three points are being assessed. Officer Colletti has not had a previous at-fault traffic crash in the previous two year period. The departments 'Crashes Involving City Vehicles' policy prescribes disciplinary guidelines in the range of a written reprimand or one-day suspension. Due to the aforementioned facts and circumstances, it is recommended that Officer Colletti receive a written reprimand..</p>


